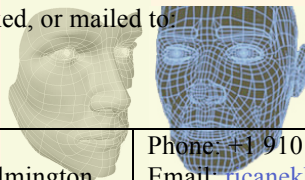

Immediate post-doctoral openings in IRL Lab/Face Aging Group on the campus of the University of North Carolina Wilmington. There are two positions currently available: **full**—competitive salary with health care benefits and **partial**—a modest monthly stipend (additional external funding will be required) with health care benefits. Both positions are for one-year with an optional second-year *contingent on performance and funding*. The funding source for these positions comes from the Department of Defense and/or the United States Intelligence Community. The positions are open for recent and current Ph.D.'s in Computer Science or Engineering who have demonstrated a deep knowledge in one of the core areas via prodigious publishing and/or presentation record. The Face Aging Group performs research in critical areas of biometrics, image and video processing, data fusion. Applicants for the open positions should have a deep knowledge (well published) in at least one core area:

- Biometrics: face recognition, iris recognition, skin/texture based techniques, multimodal fusion
- Image processing/analysis: segmentation, tracking, enhancement, feature selection, manifolds
- Pattern recognition/classification: feature analysis, discriminate analysis, clustering, meta classification, fusion

The applicants must be able to develop solutions in Matlab and C++ environments. Additionally, knowledge of statistical packages is a benefit. All applicants should send a 1) letter of interest detailing their experience in the core areas, 2) a current curricula vita, and 3) two examples of recently published referred-articles. Applications that do not have the three listed components will not be reviewed. Letters of recommendation/reference will not be needed at this time. However, contact information (including e-mail address) for three current professional references should be included in your package. The search committee will request your permission prior to contacting your professional references.
